

ARTICLE XI. SOCIAL PLUS COMMITTEE

A. Authority and Jurisdiction

The Articles of Incorporation, Art. VI - Purpose, states that the purpose of the Association, in part, is “to foster and maintain acquaintanceship and friendship among the members of the Association for social, recreation, and other group activities and events.” The Board of Directors, acting under CC&R Article V, Section I (g) and Bylaws Article VI, Section 15 established the Social Plus Committee and delegated jurisdiction for coordination of social activities of the Association to the Social Plus Committee.

B. Committee Mission

To promote social activities at Kala Point, to promote and/or coordinate community activities including charitable works, classes in areas of interest to the members, etc., and to encourage participation of all members of Kala Point Owner’s Association in community and social activities.

C. Committee Organization and Reporting

The Committee shall be reorganized and elect its chair annually following the Association’s Annual Meeting in July. The Committee shall be composed of an unlimited number of members, approved by the Board, including such Board members as will be assigned to the Committee. Its secretary shall keep regular written minutes of the meetings which shall be submitted to the Board prior to its regular monthly meeting. Its treasurer shall provide a printed treasurer’s report to the Committee at the monthly meeting.

D. Committee Objectives and Action Plan

To accomplish its mission, the Committee shall encourage such activities as:

1. Welcoming newcomers to Kala Point through parties and personal visits from neighborhood representatives with information about Kala Point, its committees, and other helpful information.
2. Arranging periodic potluck parties and other functions and gatherings.
3. Holding Friday TGIF no-host get-togethers.
4. Sending supportive greeting cards to residents of Kala Point as needed.
5. Providing a treasury for expenditures supported, in part, by an annual KPOA contribution.
6. Planning and executing an Annual County Food Bank Drive within Kala Point.
7. Overseeing and authorizing all information posted on KPOA bulletin boards.

E. Meetings

The Committee will have an annual planning meeting in September. Other meetings will be held on an as-needed basis to plan coming
